→ Here's how it works

Simply present your member ID card at a participating pharmacy the next time you fill a prescription; no need to use any other card. The most frequently used participating pharmacies are listed on the next page.

- You'll get the lowest available price between your health insurance price or, if available, a number of different discount cards.
- Over-the-counter (OTC) medications not covered by your health plan may also qualify for a discount. To see if an OTC medication qualifies, present your prescription to the pharmacy with your member ID card, and you will receive the lowest available price.
- Purchases for medications that are covered by your health plan will count toward your deductible and out-of-pocket.
- Log into your member account to search for in-network, participating pharmacies and see the lowest available price on your medications.
