

What you need to know about your coverage for

COVID-19 TESTING AND VACCINES

Coverage for COVID-19 testing and vaccines will change beginning May 12, 2023, as a result of the Federal Public Health Emergency (PHE) coming to an end. Please review the current coverage and the related changes below.

Current Coverage through May 11	Coverage May 12 and beyond
Tests covered at 100% for in-network and out-of-network providers	Tests will be covered as a standard benefit where copays, deductible or coinsurance may apply
Surveillance testing, not covered	Surveillance testing, not covered
Over-the-counter (OTC) COVID-19 tests are covered through pharmacy benefits	Over-the-counter COVID-19 tests will be excluded under the pharmacy benefit (same for all other OTC products)
Cost for telehealth and other related services to diagnose COVID-19 are waived for in-network and out-of-network providers	Telehealth and other related services to diagnose COVID-19 will be covered as a standard benefit where copays, deductible or coinsurance may apply
Administration of the COVID-19 vaccine in a medical or pharmacy setting is covered at 100% for in-network or out-of-network providers	COVID-19 vaccines administered at an in-network provider will continue to be covered at 100% under Preventive Services; out-of-network will be covered as a standard benefit where copays, deductible or coinsurance may apply
