Your prescription drug benefits are based on a list of covered brand name and generic drugs, called a formulary or prescription drug list (PDL). **Beginning <Date>**, your drug list has changed from your previous list.

## What this means for you

The drugs on your new drug list are selected based on an evaluation of safety, effectiveness, unique qualities and cost to help ensure you are receiving quality care. Please review your prescription drug list to determine coverage for any medications you or your dependent(s) may be taking. If a drug you or your dependent(s) are taking is not on the list, you may continue to take the medication, but you will be responsible for the higher, non-preferred cost share. Please consider talking with your doctor to see if a less expensive alternative would work for you.

## How to find your drug list online

- Log in to your online member services account, myNebraskaBlue.com. Select Tools & Resources, Pharmacy Benefits, then Find Medicines. Your drug list is available under the header Helpful Documents.
- Or, you may visit NebraskaBlue.com/DrugList to view your list.

You may also sign in to myPrime.com to get estimated costs for prescription drugs at in-network pharmacies.
