\$0 Prescription Drugs for Prescription Drug Lists (PDL) 20, 30, and 40

In accordance with the Affordable Care Act (ACA) requirements, your employer has chosen to provide evidence-based preventative drug coverage at \$0. Below is the list of preventive medications that may be available under your preventive drug coverage.

The drugs listed below are grouped into broad categories. Each category includes an alphabetical list of drugs. Please verify with your plan if a generic drug must be tried before the brand-name drug is covered. Please refer to your benefit materials for coverage details and your online member account for current information as this list will be reviewed periodically and is subject to change.

Generic prescription drugs are shown in lowercase, blue type. Most generic drugs are followed by a reference brand drug (in parentheses). Some generic products have no reference brand. Brand-name prescription drugs are shown in all capital letters followed by the generic name. Generic alternatives to many brand-name drugs are available, though not necessarily in all strengths.

- Aspirin: Over-the-counter (OTC) (male ages 50-59 and female ages 50-59 for cardiovascular disease; pregnant women at risk for pre-eclampsia ages 13-59)

- Breast Cancer Primary Prevention: Women at risk for certain types of cancer, aged 35 and older
 - Anastrozole tab 1 mg
 - Exemestane tab 25 mg

 - Tamoxifen citrate tab 10 mg (base equivalent)
 - Tamoxifen citrate tab 20 mg (base equivalent)
- Colonoscopy Bowel Preparation
 Medication: Generic bowel prep medication
 will be covered for members aged 45 and older.

- Iron Supplements: Prescription and OTC (ages 6-12 months)
